

## Save your time by taking Tobu Limited Express Train

Nikko pass includes only local trains that take about 3 hours and require a change of trains. Upgrade to a fast, convenient and comfortable limited express train that takes you directly to Nikko and Kinugawa Onsen in 2 hours.

NIKKO PASS all area / NIKKO PASS world heritage area + 1,650 yen ~ (one way) for Limited Express ticket between Asakusa and Tobu Nikko/ Kinugawa onsen.

※An additional fee is required for use of Limited Express trains per way.

### Limited express ticketing and online reservation service.

- Available to purchase by using devices such as smartphones and PC.
- Membership registration is not required.
- Service hours are 4:50 a.m. to 12:20 a.m. (Japan Standard Time).
- Payment can only be made by credit card.
